

By car, boat, bike or on foot these largely undiscovered treasures are just waiting for you to explore.

A cluster of islands awaits you at Redlands on Moreton Bay. Stay and explore each or hop from one to another and get to know their distinctive character.

Choose from Coochiemudlo, Macleay, Lamb, Karragarra or Russell Island and be surrounded by golden beaches, calm waters and a laidback atmosphere – once there, all you will need to do is put your feet up and relax.

Coochiemudlo Island is known for its secluded beaches and magnificent views of sparkling Moreton Bay. The island is small enough to walk or cycle around and is a delight to explore. A great way to see the island is by taking a short bus tour where a local driver will show you the main points of interest and share some tall tales. The area is popular for windsurfing, sailing, swimming and paddle boats.

This area is home to a variety of birdlife including migratory species and is a perfect

place to explore the flora and fauna. If you're looking for something a little more active, why not tee off on the island's nine-hole golf course with bay views, play tennis or enjoy a game of croquet.

Macleay Island offers a quiet, relaxed lifestyle... where you will enjoy respite from the pressures of everyday living. Revive with a coffee after a invigorating bike ride exploring the intricacies of the island, or linger over a delicious meal at the café restaurant. Meet up with friends at the local bowling club or roll a ball along the green. A leisurely round of golf is also an option. Fish, boat, swim, take a stroll along the beach or walk through the native rainforest. Enjoy a day-break or extended stay on Macleay and rediscover peace and quiet.

Lamb Island is known as the 'treasure of Moreton Bay'. Measuring only two kilometres by one kilometre at the narrowest north-eastern end, Lamb provides the perfect setting for a relaxing walk around the island to take in the natural beauty of the environment. Whether you have a boat, or just want to throw a line in from the shore, there is an abundance of fish in the waters around Lamb Island.

Karragarra Island has the smallest population of the Bay Islands with just

under 100 people making up the close-knit community. The island offers a sandy beach with netted swimming enclosure, electric and wood barbeques, picnic tables and shady trees, which are all very close to the jetty. There are no shops on the island, so make sure you bring a picnic.

Russell Island boasts panoramic views across Moreton Bay, Stradbroke Island and south towards the Gold Coast. Being the largest of the Southern Moreton Bay Islands, the island provides you with the modern conveniences of a supermarket, cafe, video shop, RSL, bowls club, taxi service, motel, doctor and many more.

GETTING THERE

To Coochiemudlo Island

A passenger ferry operates from Victoria Point every half hour, seven days a week. A vehicular barge service is also available. Once you get to the island, Coochie Bus Service will take you where you want to go.

To the other Bay Islands

A passenger ferry and vehicular barge service operates daily, departing regularly from Redland Bay ferry terminal. Bicycles, mopeds, taxis and sea kayaks are available for use once on the Island.
